### HAM-TMC Library Hosted Exhibit

Last month the HAM-TMC Library hosted the exhibit *Stamping Out Disease*. The exhibit consisted of six banners in English and Spanish that included the following topics: *Immunology: a Brave New World*; *The Golden Age of Microbiology*; and *The Rise and Spread of Infectious Disease*. This exhibit was presented in conjunction with Be Wise – Immunize<sup>SM</sup>, one of the most ambitious public health programs of the Texas Medical Association (TMA). The program, a joint initiative of TMA and the TMA Alliance (a physician spouse volunteer organization), was launched to improve childhood immunization rates in Texas.



*Stamping Out Disease* is produced by the TMA History of Medicine Committee and is funded by grants from the TMA Foundation, the statewide medical society's philanthropic arm, and Frost Bank, trustee of the Myra Stafford Pryor Charitable Trust.
