The Full Text Online button will take you directly to the full text of the journal article on the web. The Print Collection button will take you to a page linked to Voyager, the Library's online catalog for availability of the journal in our print collections.

Psychiatry Online

PsychiatryOnline is the American Psychiatric Publishing Inc.'s new portal to practice guidelines, journals, self-assessment tools and books in the field. Included are:

- DSM-IV-TR Library, including DSM-IV-TR, DSM-IV-TR Handbook of Differential Diagnosis, and Cases from DSM-IV-TR Casebook and Its Treatment Companion
- APA Practice Guidelines for the Treatment of Psychiatric Disorders
- Hales and Yudofsky: Textbook of Clinical Psychiatry, 4th edition
- APPI journals, including American Journal of Psychiatry, Psychiatric Services, and Journal of Neuropsychiatry and Clinical Neurosciences.

A search across these resources is available via the extensive Topics Index. The self-assessment tests are derived from the *Textbook of Clinical Psychiatry*, 4th edition.
