New Resource: The Chronicle of Higher Education

The Chronicle of Higher education is the newest electronic resource acquired by the Library. A special feature of this resource is access to Really Simple Syndication (RSS) feeds. RSS is a web standard for the delivery of news and other frequently updated content provided by web sites. In order to use this service from your computer and retrieve new items, you need to download an RSS reader. There are numerous RSS readers from which to choose and many are available to download free from the Web. Different RSS readers behave and display data differently.
