### ***Mobile Access to Clin-eguide: Clinical Decision Support***

Clin-eguide is a clinical decision support system that combines clinical disease management, drug therapy and laboratory testing information. It contains patient and disease-specific recommendations from Evidence-Based Guidelines, Nursing Advisor, Facts & Comparisons drug information, National Guideline Clearinghouse, the Cancer Chemotherapy Manual and also provides patient handouts.

The mobile version is compatible with:

- Palm OS
- Windows Mobile
- Blackberry
- iPhone
