Under the Productivity tab, you can find other apps, such as:

[IPassword](#): an app that helps remembering your passwords. The app is for Windows, Mac, iPhone, iPad and Android.

[Dropbox](#): Users can store documents from any device and share them through URLs using a Cloud-based storage. For Android and Apple iOS.

[Adobe Reader](#): this app allows users to read and share PDF documents, including portfolios and password-protected PDF's. Works with Android & Apple iOS.
