New Vaccines: How and Why ACIP Makes Vaccine Recommendations

The TMC Library and the UTHealth McGovern Center for Humanities and Ethics present the lecture ***New Vaccines: How and Why ACIP Makes Vaccine Recommendations***. Dr. Larry Pickering will present the lecture on Thursday, April 11, 2013 from 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m. at the University of Texas School of Public Health Auditorium, first floor, located at 1200 Herman Pressler, Houston, TX 77030.

Dr. Larry Pickering, senior advisor to the director of the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases and Executive Secretary of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), will discuss the ACIP process, using the experience with human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine as an example.
