New Library Fees

Effective September 1st, the Library will be increasing fees for coin photocopies to \$0.25 per page and copycard printouts and photocopies to \$0.20 per page.

Photocopy service for cardholders will cost \$9, Interlibrary Loan from a local library network will cost \$5, from a non-local library network will cost \$15.
