### ***New Classes Available in the Library***

In addition to the regularly scheduled classes, the HAM-TMC Library will offer classes on TOXNET and the Digital Dissertations database next year.

Digital Dissertations is the authoritative source for information about doctoral dissertations and master's theses. This database represents the work of authors from over 1,000 graduate schools and universities. Approximately 47,000 new dissertations and 12,000 new theses are added to the database each year.

To access Digital Dissertations go the Library home page <http://resource.library.tmc.edu/> click on Databases (A - Z List) and select Digital Dissertations. This database is also available for remote access at the educational level.

TOXNET – (TOXicology Data NETwork) is a group of free databases covering toxicology, hazardous chemicals, environmental health and related areas. It is managed by the [Toxicology and Environmental Health Information Program](#) (TEHIP) in the [Division of Specialized Information Services](#) (SIS) of the [National Library of Medicine](#) (NLM).
