The conditions of the above obligation
is such that the said Wm P King is bound to make or cause
to be made a warrantable title to the following quantities
of Land to wit three hundred and ~~Twenty~~ ^{of Land} acres
I saw A W M Pearson one hundred acres which
I saw Nath Seavey two hundred and twenty acres of
land which I saw E Bonner and six hundred and
forty acres of land which I devote to said Mist
for his service said lands to be taken out of
the unappropriated lands of said King in his
Survey on the waters of Trinity the debts to be
paid as soon as the land can be removed
given under my hand this 13th day of August 1841
