The National Library of Medicine (NLM) and the American College of Physicians Foundation (ACP Foundation) teamed up for the Information Rx Program. This program provides information and tools to assist physicians in referring patients to MedlinePlus, an authoritative, user-friendly, and commercial-free Internet site for health information. The cornerstone of the project is the information prescription pad, designed to be used by physicians to prescribe MedlinePlus to their patients.

*MedlinePlus* offers interactive tutorials on over 165 health topics, such as diabetes and preventing heart disease, in English and

Spanish. These interactive tutorials provide easy-to-understand information through animation with audio and subtitles, making the tutorials ideal for patients with lower literacy levels. The interactive tutorials offer introductory information on a variety of subjects, covering diseases and conditions, tests and diagnostic procedures, surgery and treatment procedures, and prevention and wellness. Patients are prompted with review questions throughout the tutorials to reinforce learning.
