New Feature in PubMed:Email Updates

Would you like to receive e-mail updates of your research topic in PubMed? You can do it by using My NCBI. The first step is to perform a search in PubMed. Click on the "save search" link located at the end of the search box. You will be prompted to sign in for My NCBI. If you are not a registered user, click on REGISTER first and fill in the information. Once you have registered, save your search. The system will prompt you to receive e-mail updates on your topic. Select yes.
