Library Offers Over 6,000 Online Journals and Cuts Print Resources

The "E-Journals A - Z List" on the Library's website (<u>http://resource.library.tmc.edu</u>) now links you to over 6,000 biomedical and life sciences online journals. Access to many of these journals is made possible by our participation in a consortium of The University

of Texas libraries that negotiates contracts for "bundles" of journals at favorable prices. As electronic journals have grown in number and popularity, the Library has responded to its Library clients needs.

Beginning in January, 2007, the Library will receive just over 350 journals in print. All other journals will be available in electronic format only. Usage statistics for both print and electronic journals indicate that users prefer to access the journal literature online. The print journals will continue to be housed in the Library but will no longer be current.

Journal Cancellations For 2007

Due to budget constraints, the Library is cancelling both the print and electronic versions of 124 journals. Criteria for cancellation included: price, average annual print use and cost of print use, average annual electronic use and cost of electronic use, and the ISI impact factor of the journal.
