The HAM-TMC Library is pleased to announce that the traveling exhibition *Deadly Medicine: Creating the Master Race* from the [United States Holocaust Memorial Museum](#) is on display through August 24.

The exhibition contains historical photographs, films, and testimony from Holocaust survivors. It is a self-guided tour that takes approximately 20-30 minutes to see.

The HAM-TMC Library is the first library to host this exhibition. It was previously displayed at different museums and galleries across the country.

Share Your PubMed Bibliography Using My NCBI

You can share your PubMed bibliography with your colleagues using My NCBI. The first step is to save your results in a collection. To do so follow these steps:

- Sign in to My NCBI
- Run a PubMed search, then on the results page, select the items you want to save
- Select *Collections* under the *Send to* menu
- On the *Save Collection* window you may create a new collection or append to an existing collection-- enter a collection name

To share a Collection while on My NCBI

- Under *My Saved Data*, click the *Collections Manage* link
- Click *Private* next to the collection you want to share
- Select the *Public* radio button
- Copy the **Direct URL** and share it with your colleagues, or
- Copy and paste the **HTML for Web Pages and Blogs** into blogs or webpages to include the collection in the page itself
- Very important: Click **Save**
