HAM-TMC Library to Complete Process of Individual User Authentication

All HAM-TMC Library users will be required to log in with Remote Access usernames and passwords to access licensed/subscribed electronic resources (databases, e-journals and e-books) **starting September 1st, 2009**. Your Remote Access login will be necessary regardless of physical location. You will only need to log in once per session as long as your browser window remains open.
